- The Program:** In response to the devastating earthquake in Haiti and the humanitarian crisis that has ensued, Operation:Haiti is collecting high-need items for large, material-goods shipments to the people of Haiti.

- How to Help:** Participating towns are engaging the following activities:
- Informing their town residents of Operation:Haiti through links on their web sites and other local communication vehicles
  - Providing drop-off locations at town facilities; goods will be picked up by Operation:Haiti trucks.
  - Organizing school collections, which are picked up by Operation:Haiti trucks
  - Directing financial donations to the Operation:Haiti Fund
- Items to Donate:** The following items are currently being collected:
- Clean, labeled summer clothing
  - Baby clothes
  - New undergarments
  - Clean, gently-worn shoes, sandals and flip-flops
  - Cloth Diapers
  - Bar Soap
  - Deodorant
  - Anti-bacterial wipes
  - Candles
- Storehouse Location:** All donated items can be delivered to: Joseph's Storehouse, located at 519 Bic Drive, Milford CT, where they are sorted and packed by volunteers.
